General Requirements:

- Must apply to UVA within two years from the date you obtain the VCCS Associate Degree
- Earn a minimum of 54 transferable credit hours- minimum may include dual enrollment credit, but not AP or IB credit
- Earn at least a 3.4 GPA (for courses repeated both grades used in calculating GPA)
- Earn no lower than a “C” in every VCCS course taken
- In Eng 111 & 112, student must earn no lower than a “B”
- Average GPA of incoming transfer students from VCCS was 3.7
- March 1st application deadline for fall transfer

Specific Course Requirements:

- **English Composition**- cannot use dual enrollment courses. Those with dual enrollment must take Eng 210 & receive a “B” or better, or student may retake the Eng 111 & 112 at VCCS.
- **Foreign Language**- Must be through 202 level, not dual enrollment. May satisfy by qualifying scores in SAT, AP, or IB foreign language subject tests. Will accept ASL 201 and 202 (level 3 and 4). No credit for 101/102 foreign lang. level
- **Social Sciences (6 credits)**- 2 transferable courses from two different disciplines (government, sociology, psychology or economics).
These 2 NRCC courses transfer best: Psy 200, PLS 135
- **Humanities (6 credits)**- 1 transferable course in two of the three groups:
Literature (classics/comparative/English/foreign) Fine Arts (Art/Music/Drama)
Moral, philosophical, religious (political theory, philosophy, religion)
- **Historical Studies (3 credits)**- 1 transferable history course
- **Non-Western Perspective**- 1 transferable course nonwestern culture (**Soc 266**)
- **Natural Science & Mathematics**- (12 credits) Transferable in at least two disciplines- mathematics, biology, chemistry, physics, environmental science, astronomy. Mathematics may include statistics. Mth 163 will not satisfy this area (but will count towards degree credit). Suggest: mth 152 & 157; or Mth 175/177 & mth 176/178; or Mth 271& 272; or Mth 271 & Mth 241.

Once at UVA to earn a degree student must:

- **Take 15 credits each semester- or enroll in summer sessions at UVA**
- **Declare a major by the end of the first semester- can use VCCS courses to fulfill area and elective requirements, but usually VCCS will not satisfy major requirements.**
- **Earn a total of 120 credits, 60 credits must be from UVA**
- **Complete coursework, all major requirements and graduation requirements in no more than 4 full time semesters.**
